Councilman Pennington encouraged all of us to attend the monthly PIP meetings at HPD. The Briarhills Traffic Committee held a public meeting on March 30<sup>th</sup> at Temple Sinai. Today the mayor presented her budget to city council. The budget should be adopted sometime next week. A sobering center for the city has been approved. The widening of Eldridge between Memorial and I10 has begun and will last until November.

Bob presented handouts with the crime statistics in our area...not as high as the Houston Chronicle had reported.
