

## Minutes from the meeting of July 13, 2016 – Super Neighborhood 17

- I. Call to order at 7:00 p.m.
- II. Representatives' Announcements
- III. Speakers – There was no representative from District G.  

Van, representative from District F was present, and provided an update the activities of the area covered by District F. He noted that the City and the County were working on a Hike and Bike Trail in the area. Also, the dead end street at Brae Meadow at Synott, which is a dead end was being barricaded. Neighborhood Protection will install an 8FT wood fence to stop dumping and parking. There is an abandoned home at Wilcrest at Bellaire that is going to be torn down as the owner had been found and he agreed to the tear down. Park Hollow, Sec. 5 concerning needed repairs will be on CIP list. Questions on the entrance/exit at Eagles Trace off of HWY 6 had become a hazardous area. Information was requested as to whether this is a City, County, or State issue could help with the traffic problem on HWY6. A suggestion was made for a blinking yellow light to be installed apart from the light which would notify the driver a stop light was coming up.
- IV. Metro Representative Dunlap noted that a meeting with Metro and City took place on June 25. The round table discussion with the Mayor Turner and Metro, concerned criminals and homeless and the use of Kush, which is synthetic marijuana causing panic attacks, dizziness and paranoia. Federal and State have set up bans on making of the herbs and chemicals that make up the drug. The Mayor wants to take back the parks and add police in parks to reduce the selling of Kush. Metro will start a program of more stringent enforcement along with other violations at the major transit areas. Metro police will start enforcing Ordinance 02504, which states laying on the sidewalks is illegal, and Ordinance 92309 which prohibits aggressive panhandling.
